

Illustrative Guide to Assist in the Purchase of Acceptable School Shoes

	<p>Acceptable Boys Shoes: Features:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Black leather - Laced or Velcro - Upper foot protection - Non-slip sole 	
	<p>Unacceptable Boys Shoes: Features:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Splashes of colour/white (shoes must be totally black, inc. shoelaces and sole) - Canvas upper Eg Rabens, Converse 	
	<p>Acceptable Girl's Shoes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Leather upper providing protection to the majority of the upper foot - Laced (preferred) or strapped* (leather strap) - Heal and sole with non-slip grip. 	
 <p style="text-align: center;">Ballet Flats are not acceptable</p>	<p>Unacceptable Girl's Shoes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The majority of the upper foot is unprotected. - Smooth sole with little grip - No/token heel - Thin/soft leather offering little protection. 	
<p>Sports Shoes</p> 		<p>Acceptable Sports Shoes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lace up/Velcro (no slip-ons or dress shoes) - Covers all of the top of the foot - Provides grip, arch support and sole protection

** Students undertaking practical based subjects need to wear lace-up shoes that protect their feet against drops and spills. O H & S requirements may result in students who are not wearing shoes with sufficient protection being excluded from some practical activities. If in doubt please purchase lace-up shoes.*
