Meetings are a great avenue to network with other parents.

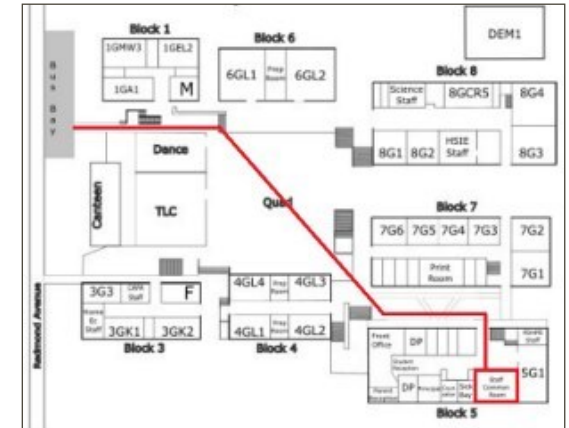
Some meetings will have guest speakers and topical information sessions.
