Appointments

For the first time, we will be trialling an online booking system for early morning, 15-minute fitting appointments.

As of 23rd October 2023, for two weeks only until 3rd November 2023, the Uniform Shop will be accepting appointments starting at 7:15am until 8:15am.

In the interest of time, please know your child's approximate size. If the trial is successful, we will continue using appointments.

Open Fitting Dates

The Uniform Shop will have two "special" opening days on the following Saturdays, for student uniform fittings.

Saturday 2nd December 2023 9:00am – 1:00pm (Year 7, 2024 students only)

Saturday 20th January 2024 9:00am – 1:00pm (All students welcome)

On these days we will have many volunteers, separate change areas for boys & girls and a specific payment area to ensure a fast and smooth uniform purchase.

Online orders can also be picked up on these days.

We strongly recommend that you organise your uniform needs as early as possible and do not leave it to the last weeks before the start of school.

Ordering Online

Ordering online is a fast and easy option to fulfilling your uniform needs. It is a much-preferred method of purchase.

Tip: We suggest that you do not put money into your Munch Monitor account as small, unused amounts generally tend to sit there. It is better to pay the full amount at the time of purchase.

Canteen orders or food purchases on account are not available through Munch Monitor.

If you already have an account with Munch Monitor at your existing school, you will need to also set up a profile with Model Farms High School. Please do not try and change your child's existing profile. **Select YR7/24 as your child's class.**

Once your Munch Monitor account has been set up, please select **Class YR7/24** when ordering.

Uniform Collections

During the school term, orders will be available for collection the same day from the Uniform Shop. (If placed before 6:45am) Entry is via Redmond Avenue. Families with students currently at Model Farms that wish for them to collect an order, please place the order under their name and year group.

Email confirmations and reminders are not sent.

Please collect your order within one week of ordering and **please bring your receipt as proof of purchase.** There is limited storage space in the shop at this peak time.

The last day for collections, refunds and exchanges is **Friday 15th December 2023**

Collection, Returns & Exchanges
